APPROVED MINUTES OF THE
REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS
Thursday, October 16, 2025

The Governing Board of the Southern Inyo Fire Protection District held a regular business meeting on Thursday, October 16, 2025 at 6pm at the Hurlbut Rook Community Center.

I. Call to order and determination of quorum

Present: Robin Flinchum, Chair, Cameron Mayer, Vice-Chair, Eliza Woodall, Secretary, Spencer McNeal, Director, Colette Zelwer (via Zoom), Mike Jerry, Larry Levy, Patrick Donnelly (via Zoom). Flinchum calls meeting to order at 6:04 and established a quorum.

 - a.i. Brush truck is at Levy's being worked on. Ambulance transmission has been repaired but still has apparent fuel issues to be figured out before it can be used in the field.

- K. Long-Term Planning
 - a. Fire Stations
 - a.i. Donnelly update: The solar project is still pre-permit which is the best time to get our needs voiced. He has been talking to other small fire districts regarding lithium battery fires; we need the developer to pay for representation for us (not uncommon). Patrick reached out to a few firms with no real feedback. We need a readiness assessment (our strengths and what gaps need to be filled) and an assessment of battery storage size, implications. We can give a preliminary assessment but need to bring in actual experts to advocate on our behalf. They have a lot of money so don't get dissuaded by any poverty claims by them. Right now they have no transmission line to get their juice to the grid and Trump has said he will not approve any new lines, so they are in a weaker spot. They have a done-deal project but with no transmission connection it's still iffy. Battery storage is part of the developer's proposal, but currently isn't allowed in Inyo County. They will have to write an exemption/policy to allow it. Does the community want to allow it? Need to make our preferences known to the county! The board will let Donnelly take the lead for us in the special meeting on 11/4 with the County and developer as he has lots of experience dealing with these folks. He will get with Jerry to make the agenda.
